There is now a practical avenue that can be offered with more insight if a woman comes to the MRC who is unable to care for her unborn child. Megan Kennedy also gave practical insight on counseling birth moms if they are looking for another option besides abortion.

The volunteers were engaged and asked a lot of good questions. God used the time wisely and allowed those in attendance to truly learn something new.
